Winchester's plant superintendent Nelson King devised a convenient loading gate that passed cartridges through the side of the receiver. This not only made the new rifle more functional but also allowed for the installation of a wooden fore-end. The handy carbine version of the 1866 Yellowboy was the first true cowboy lever-action rifle and was the first rifle widely carried in a cowboy-style saddle scabbard. The new 1866 Yellowboy was a hit worldwide. Chief Sitting Bull had an 1866, Benito Juarez's forces used Yellowboys in Mexico, and the Turkish army used the new Winchester against the Russians. Manufactured in Italy by Uberti. Uberti is a well known manufacturer of high quality replicas of 19th century American percussion revolvers, carbines and rifles.
